

Graf Hardegg in Vintrust's Sommer Selections March 2008

97 points - 2004 Graf Hardegg Gruner Veltliner 'Reserve Vom Schloss'

Weinviertel-West.

Made from old vines planted around the Castle of Schloss (Chateau) Seefeld, where grapes have been grown since the Middle Ages. Produced with minimal intervention in the vineyards or winery, resulting in extremely traditional and age-worthy wines.

94 points – 2005 Graf Hardegg Riesling 'Vom Schloss' Weinviertel West.

Graf Hardegg is helping to lead the quality revolution in Austria's Weinviertel region. This wine is made with 10% botrytized grapes, lending petrol and nutty aromas. Grapes are picked by hand from 33 – year old vines surrounding the Schloss Seefeld (Chateau)
