South Styria (Südsteiermark) is known as Austria's Tuscany, and its sparkling rosé is called schilcher sekt in German.

Strohmeier's nonvintage version is a seductive introduction to the genre. Made from blauer wildbacher grapes, this light, zippy aperitif smells like tea roses and tastes like caraway.
