Vineyard:	Prädium, highest elevation in Andau
Soil:	Red rocks, gravel & clay
Climate:	Mild microclimate with hot summers-the town of Andau has more sunny days & warmer temperatures than anywhere else in Austria
Yield:	40 hl/ha
Grapes:	20.00° KMW
Harvest:	By hand
Fermentation:	Maceration of skins for a few days
Aging:	12 months in 80% French +20% American 225 ltr oak barrels; 6 months in bottle before release
Malolactic Fermentation:	Yes
Alcohol:	13,5 %vol
Total acidity:	4,7 g/l
Residual sugars:	1,9 g/l, dry
Taste:	Deep, dark red, lush ripe berry fruit , creamy vanilla notes, with velvety tannins marking a multi-layered finish
