Soil	Heavy loam
Vine Variety	Blaufränkisch Blaufränkisch, aka "Lemberger", is indigenous to Austria and a very important grape variety in Burgenland
Grape Treatment	Sustainable
Harvest	By hand in 300 kg boxes, gentle pressing with 0.4par
Vintage	September 2007
Vintage 2007	2007 was a dry and warm year, grapes were ripe with good tannis and ripe acidity.
Vinification	Maceration 14 days, sponateous yeast fermentation in stainless steel, no enzymes, no concentrations, filtration at botteling, no fining, manual temperature control
Aging	10 months in 225 liter 3-year-old French Barrique casks
Analysis	13 % vol. of alcohol, 1,8 g/l residual-sugar
Best	2009- 2014
Degustation-note	Powerful ruby garnet with violet highlights Black currant and blackberry on the nose Subtle impression of sweetness, cherry flavours and huckleberry on the palate, dark cherries in retro-olfaction
