

Schlicht und Ergreifend Orange Cuvèe 2015 (unfiltered)

Winemaker: Georg Schmelzer

Varietals: 33% Grüner Veltliner, 33% Weißburgunder und 33% Sämling

Wine Region: Neusiedlersee, Burgenland

Climate: Pannonian climate zone. Hot, dry summers and cold snowless winters, as well as moderate precipitation. An important factor for this special microclimate is the Neusiedler See, the largest steppe lake of Central Europe.

Vineyard: Fürstliches Prädium, Reitacker, Haide, Setzlust

Soil: clay, gravel, sand, chalk

Vineyard Treatment:

Biodynamic-Organic DEMETER certified, dry farming, hand harvesting

Vinification:

No added sulphur, unfiltered, orange

Grapes unadorned, not pressed (but rather produced without pressure), not pumped forcefully but brought into the small wooden barrel and into the bottle by means of gravity. Fermented on the mash, malolactic fermentation.

Alcohol:	13	%vol
Acidity:	5,6	g/l
Residual suger:	1,3	g/l

Tasting notes:

Amber in color, Aromas of herbs, cedar and orange blossom, pineapple and roasted hazelnuts on the palate.
